Out of Bounds ~ Defined by White stakes.

Penalty Areas ~ Penalty Areas are defined as either Red or Yellow stakes. This affects all players relief options. **See Rule 17.1d**

Storm Safety ~ Be sure to exercise caution when you see rainfall, threatening clouds and/or when thunder roars by immediately seeking shelter indoors.

Property Damage ~ This course plays through residential communities. Damage due to an errant shot is the responsibility of the golfer. You are required to report any and all damage to the Golf Shop immediately upon completion of your round. Players failing to report damage will be permanently barred from the course.

Pace of Play ~ Keep pace with the group ahead of you. If you cannot, you will be asked to pick up your ball and move ahead. Failure to do so may result in dismissal from the golf course.

Net Double Bogey ~ A score equal to the par of a hole plus two strokes and adjusted for any handicap strokes applied on that hole. A net double bogey is a players maximum hole stroke for handicap purposes. **See Rule 3.1**
